

Readings: 2 Thessalonians 1.1-12 & Luke 19.1-10

All Saints

When we think of saints, we might picture patron saints, sculptures in churches, or the Pope declaring someone a Saint. Yet none of these matches what Scripture teaches.

In the NRSV Bible translation we use in church, the word "saints" appears 24 times—and every time it refers not to a select few, but to all God's people: all those who trust and follow Jesus. In other words, the Bible's answer to "Who is a saint?" is



wonderfully simple: if you are a follower of Jesus, you are one.

This Sunday, as we celebrate All Saints' Day, we remember that every believer—past, present, and future—is part of one great company of saints, joined together in Christ. The Book of Common Prayer describes this day as a reminder of "the unity of Christians of all ages, countries, and races in Christ, and the perfection of that unity in heaven." Scripture puts it another way: we are called to be saints, part of the great cloud of witnesses whose lives tell of God's unfailing love and grace.




